"We're very excited about David leading our softball program. For the past six years we've operated with a part-time head coach, and it's been difficult building the program," said Director of Athletics Mike Clary.

Coach Hicks is a 1995 graduate of Kenyon College in Gambier, Ohio. A native of Chapmanville, West Virginia, he was a four-year starter on the Lords baseball team, where he played 2nd base and pitcher.

"I'm very excited about the opportunity to lead this team. We have a solid group of returning players who bring a wealth of experience and will be much improved," said Hicks. "We have good players, and our excellent facilities will help us to recruit more good players as we build the program."
